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How you can support your child's learning:

- Encouraging your child to read regularly - try to make it part of their daily routine
- Homework - every child will be given a piece of maths, spelling and comprehension to be completed each week.
- Weekly spellings will be sent home on a Thursday and tested on the following Tuesday.
- Talk to your child about what they did - and better still what they learnt at school each day.
- Send in PE kit every Monday and take it home on Friday.
- Make sure all clothes are labelled.
- Attendance is vital - please ensure that your child is here every day to build on their learning.

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Working together:

- I look forward to seeing you all at parents evening in October, where we will be able to discuss your child's learning in detail, including assessment data and predicted levels.
- We will be leaving from this door every evening, so I will always be here to speak to if you have an issue - and to share good news and achievements too.
- Every day is important in helping your child to reach their potential, and I am really looking forward to working together this year.
