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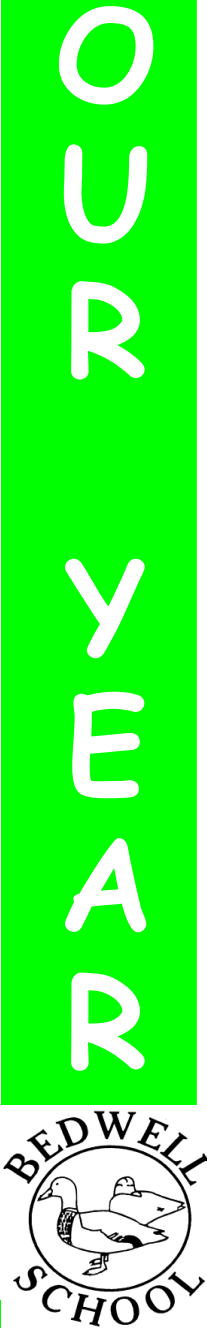


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Topics & Key Learning

 - addition and subtraction using different methods
 - number bonds to 10, 20
 - count in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Science - Materials, Plants, Animals and Habitats
- Humanities - The Great Fire of London, Explorers, India

- Always come and see me if you have any concerns - you'll often only get one side of the issue otherwise. Door is always open at the end of the day. My priority is to have your children happy and content when at school.

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How you can support your child's learning:

- Reading together regularly - try to make it part of your daily routine - aim for couple pages a night. Every time the children read, they receive a point.
- Homework - every child will receive a reading book and this will be checked and changed Monday and Thursday.
- Spellings will go out on Thursday and be due in Tuesdays - more information to follow.
- Talk to your child about what they did - and better still what they learnt at school today.
- PE is on a Tuesday and Wednesday. They will need a pair of joggers/leggings as they will do PE outside. Make sure all

clothes are labelled and they become lost very easily.

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Working together:

- Look forward to talking to you at parents evening on 12th October, where we will be able to discuss your child's learning in detail.
- Every day is very important for your child. Please try to attend each day, as each day really supports your child in reaching their full potential. We also win the attendance trophy each week.
- Please remember to let us know who will collect your child if it is a different person. We will not let them go without knowing who is collecting in advance.

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
